AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/DOLLARS (\$65,000.00) FROM UNAPPROPRIATED MONIES IN THE GENERAL FUND 101 TO THE CREDIT MONITORING SERVICES EXPENSE ACCOUNT 101-900-51860 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in 2022, The City of Whitehall contracted with IDX services regarding credit monitoring and an expense account was created which requires a 2023 appropriation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Council of the City of Whitehall authorizes and approves an appropriation in the amount of sixty-five thousand and no/dollars (\$65,000.00) from unappropriated monies in the General Fund 101 to the General Fund expense account titled "credit monitoring services".

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and welfare and for the further reason it is now necessary to fund this account in order to pay invoices that will be received in near future; WHEREFORE, This Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 018-2023 (Admin/Fin. Mgmt. – 1st reading – ADOPT 04/04/2023-Bailey/

AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE CREATION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TAX LEVY FUND (280), APPROPRIATING TWO HUNDRED NINETY ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$291,380.00) FROM UNAPPROPRIATED MONIES IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TAX LEVY FUND (280) TO THE POLICE DEBT EXPENSE ACCOUNT (280.000.50000) AND APPROPRIATING SIXTEEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$16,000.00) FROM UNAPPROPRIATED MONIES IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TAX LEVY FUND (280) TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TAX LEVY FEE EXPENSE ACCOUNT (280.000.52000) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the administration of the City of Whitehall now brings to the Council of the City of Whitehall for their consideration and approval to create a new special revenue fund and expense account(s) for the proper accounting for the fund collected from the Police Department Tax Levy approved on the Whitehall voters on May 3, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to hold these funds to pay for allowable expenses for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings used directly in the operation of the police department, for the payment of salaries of permanent or part-time police, communications, or administrative personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.33 of the Revised Code, for the provision of ambulance or emergency medical services operated by the police department, or for the payment of other related costs; and directly related to the operation of the police department as approved by the voters; and

WHEREAS, certain that this account will have deposits received directly or by transfer during the calendar year 2023 thereby requiring an appropriation before disbursement for the intended purpose and requiring that monies be appropriated at this time; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEHALL, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Council of the City of Whitehall approves the creation of the Police Department Tax Levy Fund (280).

SECTION 2: That an appropriation is hereby made from unappropriated monies in the Police Department Tax Levy Fund (280) to the Police Department Debt Expense Account (280.000.50000) in the amount of two hundred ninety one thousand three hundred and no/100 (\$291,380.00) and an appropriation is hereby made from unappropriated monies in the Police Department Tax Levy Fund (280) to the Police Department Tax Levy Fees Expense Account (280.000.52000) in the amount of sixteen thousand and no/100 dollars (\$16,000.00).

SECTION 3: That the City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the City for these funds for the purpose stated.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety, and welfare and for further reason that the city is required to hold these monies in a dedicated fund for tracking purposes; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
