

Proclamation by the Mayor

Proclamation and Issuing Executive Orders effective February 28, 2022

WHEREAS, the spread of COVID-19 within our community has lessened due to the increase of vaccination rates, the wearing of facemasks and social distancing; and

WHEREAS, the Covid-19 positivity rate is 5.74% and is in the “moderate range; and

WHEREAS, the Covid-19 transmission rates has shrunk considerably; and

WHEREAS, it is important that the wearing of facemasks still continue for those who have compromised immune systems and/or care for those with compromised immune systems and/or are recovering from illness; and

WHEREAS, effective Monday, February 28, 2022, I, the Mayor of the City of Whitehall, Ohio, will cease the mandate of wearing a facemask in public indoor spaces; and

Because of the rescinding of the facemask order, I call upon all citizens, visitors, and those working within the City of Whitehall to continue to be vigilant in the efforts to slow the COVID-19 virus in order to promote a healthier Whitehall and central Ohio region through vaccinations and staying home when you are ill.
